Plaid Shorts (K4 & K5)	Linda's – School Apparel Young Fashion - Fit America or Official School Uniform Fashion World- Royal Park or Tulane	2" above knee or longer Must have elastic waistband all the way around shorts – no zipper or button
Plaid Shorts (1st-12th) *see note below	Linda's – ST315 Young Fashion – 70 Fashion World – 42	2" above knee; cannot exceed the bottom of the knee. Must be loose fitting. A belt must be worn if shorts have belt loops.
Plaid Jumpers (K4-4th)	Linda's – ST315 Young Fashion – 70 Fashion World – 42	Must touch the floor when kneeling No logo will be imprinted
Plaid Skirt (5th-12th)	Linda's – ST315 Young Fashion – 70 Fashion World – 42	Must touch the floor when kneeling Stitch-down or box pleat
Khaki Pants (K4 & K5)	Linda's – School Apparel Young Fashion – Fit America or Official School Uniform Fashion World – Classroom	Must have elastic waistband all the way around pants – no zipper or button Can be worn year-round Must be loose fitting
Khaki Pants (1st-12th) *see note below	Linda's – School Apparel Young Fashion – Royal Park or Official School Uniform Fashion World – Classroom	Can be worn year-round Flat or pleated front Must be loose fitting Must wear belt at all times
Undershirts (K4-12th)	Can be purchased anywhere	White short sleeve t-shirt NO writing on t-shirt The sleeve must NOT show past the sleeve of the uniform shirt
Shirts (K4-12th)	Linda's – School Apparel Young Fashion – Extrem or Royal Park Fashion World – Tulane. Classroom. or French Toast	White polo with banded bottom (this is the only polo allowed for 2011-2012; must have LCA logo. Short or long sleeve permitted
Socks/Tights (K4-12th)	Can be purchased anywhere	Solid white, gray, or navy blue Crew, high ankle, or knee socks (<u>socks must be visible above shoe</u>) Navy, white, gray, or flesh tights are allowed but must be worn with socks (tights MUST be footed-not a legging) No logos or stripes

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. LCA's logo (a patch) is mandatory on all uniforms shirts; it will not be attached to the jumper. It will be khaki on the navy blue shirts and navy on the white shirts. **Check individual stores regarding their policy on attaching the logo patch on shirts not purchased from them.**
2. **White** short sleeve t-shirts (**no writing on them**) can be worn under girls' and boys' uniform shirts. Boys may wear navy blue t-shirts (**no writing on them**) under uniform shirt. Girls may have only the top button unbuttoned on their uniform shirt.
3. If an LCA sweatshirt or hoodie is worn in class, it is to be worn on top of school shirt at all times. Collar of school shirt or blouse must be exposed. School shirt/blouse must be tucked in at all times.
4. Hats and beanies are allowed to be worn to school, but cannot be worn in the classroom. Baseball caps and bandanas are not to be worn on school grounds. They may be worn during PE at the discretion of the teacher, i.e. softball/baseball season.

Grooming

Students in grades K4-6th are not allowed to wear make-up; students in grades 7th-12th may wear makeup in moderation. Moderation will be determined by administration. Girls are not to wear excessive jewelry – discretion of the teacher. Girls will be allowed to wear (2) pierced earrings. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings at any time. Girls and boys are allowed to wear a total of three (3) rings. All jewelry must be removed from PE classes and locked in PE lockers.

Boys

- Hair cannot exceed the top of the eye when opened
- Hair cannot exceed past the bottom of the ear lobe
- Hair cannot touch the top of the collar of school uniform
- Adding gel substances to the hair to disguise the length will not be allowed
- Sideburns cannot extend beyond the ear lobe
- Hair should be natural color; cannot have extreme hair colors
- Hair should be tapered so obvious lines are not visible
- Hair cannot be braided
- Afro haircuts should not exceed two inches in length
- Cannot have mustaches or beards; must be clean shaven

Girls

- Hair must be a natural color; cannot have extreme hair colors
- When hair is highlighted, there cannot be a clear definition/color change (i.e. stripe or one unnatural color)
- Hair cannot be shaved or defined lines

VIOLATION OF DRESS CODE DISCIPLINE

All students in violation of the dress code will be issued a uniform deficiency slip or in violation of hair cut policy will be issued a haircut deficiency slip for parental signature.

- **K4-2nd**: Failure to comply with the guidelines on the uniform or hair cut deficiency slip will result in disciplinary action for the student.
- **3rd-12th**: Failure to comply with the guidelines on the uniform or hair cut deficiency slip will result in disciplinary action for the student. A student will serve a detention on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th infraction. Upon the 6th infraction, a one day suspension will take place. A one-day suspension and a detention will continue to alternate until the end of the quarter. **This disciplinary action will reset each quarter.** If the uniform/haircut deficiencies are not taken care of, the student may be removed from Lafayette Christian Academy at the discretion of the administration.
