

Junior Visual Arts

The Visual Arts competition provides students the opportunity to showcase their artistic talents and creative abilities. Each club may enter one entry in each category. This competition is designed to encourage creativity, innovation, reward outstanding craftsmanship, and reinforce the importance of fine arts.

An individual student may enter only ONE Visual Arts Category.

No Preassembled Kits Should be Used

Black & White Photography

Color Photography

Digital Art - any art created digitally

Digitally Enhanced Photography - an original photograph that is enhanced or altered from its origin. (Note: the original and digitally enhanced photograph must be submitted for judging.)

Drawing - pen, pencil, ink, charcoal, etc.

Fiber Arts - fine art whose material consist of natural or synthetic fiber and other components such as fabric or yarn

Hand-drawn Anime

Jewelry - only one entry can be submitted to be judged (i.e. pair of earrings, a bracelet, a necklace, etc.) Sets are not permitted.

Mixed Media - more than one medium used

Painting - oil, acrylic, water color, tempera, pastel, etc.

Pottery

Quilling - strips of paper that are rolled, shaped, and glued to create a design can be abstract

Recyclable Art - recycling of materials to create art

Sculpture

Woodworking

Competition Guidelines

- The Visual Art Identification Tag is included in the handbook. Print, complete in full, and attach to each Visual Art entry.
- An individual may enter only **one** category. Clubs are limited to one entry per category per division.
- Easels will not be supplied.
- All artwork must be submitted and displayed at the designated time.
- Students must be registered for the convention in order to enter artwork.
- Entries must remain on display until the designated time of pickup.
- Although reasonable precautions to protect entries will be taken, National Beta will not be responsible for loss or damage. It is the responsibility of clubs entering the contest to collect entered items at the designated times.
- Entries may not be inappropriate or explicit in nature.

All Plaques Awarded at State Convention

Judging Criteria

Holistic style judging will be used to determine the award winners in the arts competition. Judges will use the following to determine the winners:

Creativity – originality, innovation

Composition – lines, simplicity, balance, color contrast, details

Focus - degree of sharpness or softness, depth of field

Lighting - exposure, direction quality, use of shadows, shading

Technique – camera angle, paint strokes, application and experimentation of medium, texture

Primary visual impact – subject matter

Presentation – appearance, overall artistic appeal

Degree of difficulty, complexity

- Artwork size is not specified. Framing and matting of the artwork is not required.
- Easels are not provided by National Beta.
