- **11th Honors read *The Pearl* by John Steinbeck.**
- **12th Honors read *The Picture of Dorian Gray* by Oscar Wilde.**

Students should read the book for their grade level and annotate it (take notes on it). Upon return to school in August, the students will take a test within the first week back from summer break.
